PhD. Justyna Olędzka

is an Associate Professor of History and International Relations, University of Białystok, Secretary of the Centre for Post-Soviet Studies, Member of the Analytical Group "Belarus in the Region" at the Centre for Eastern European Studies, University of Warsaw.

Her research interests focus on the legitimization and delegitimization of state leadership in the CIS, propaganda in undemocratic regimes, as well as the theory and practice of social engineering.

PhD. Maxim Rust

is a researcher and lecturer at the Centre for Eastern European Studies at the University of Warsaw, Secretary of the Analytical Group "Belarus in the Region" of the Centre for Eastern European Studies at the University of Warsaw. He is a political scientist and sociologist. He studies the political elites of the post-Soviet countries and the functioning of societies in the digital environment.

Co-editor of the New Eastern Europe journal and editor of the BY2020-UA2022 portal.





PhD. Pavel Usov

is an independent Belarusian expert and analyst. He is a Head of the Centre for Political Analysis and Forecasting. He deals with the functioning and transformation of authoritarian regimes and geopolitical processes in the post-Soviet space. He is also an expert of the analytical group "Belarus in the Region" of the Centre for Eastern European Studies at the University of Warsaw.

PhD. Katarzyna Bieliakowa

lectured at universities in Belarus and Lithuania, also promoted legal education and expanded access to legal aid for certain social groups (poor people, and people with disabilities, migrants, etc.). In her scientific work she dealt with instrumental theory of law and its application in rule-making processes, as well as improving the legal system of Belarus.

She is currently conducting legal and comparative research on the regulation of migration processes in Poland and Belarus. She is a member of the analytical group "Belarus in the Region" of the Center for Eastern European Studies at the University of Warsaw.



Oleksandr Shevchenko

is Ukrainian analyst, expert of the Analytical Group "Belarus in the Region" of the Centre for Eastern European Studies at the University of Warsaw, worked in the Department of European Integration of the Ministry of Economic Development of Ukraine. Analyst of the European Centre for Non-Governmental Projects and journalist on the psz.pl portal.





Kacper Wańczyk

is a former diplomat who worked at the Polish embassies in Minsk and Kabul, at the EU EUBAM Libya mission, and also headed the Department of Ukraine and Moldova in the Eastern Department of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. He has published articles on Polish Eastern policy, Belarus and Russia. He is a member of the analytical group "Belarus in the Region" of the Centre for Eastern European Studies at the University of Warsaw.



PhD. Aliaksandr Papko

is Belarusian political scientist and journalist, a member of the Analytical Group "Belarus in the Region" of the Centre for Eastern European Studies at the University of Warsaw. He collaborates with Belsat TV Channel and EAST Centre. He is the author of scientific articles on the economic system and foreign policy of Belarus, the Belarusian media, as well as the ideology of the Belarusian government.
